- 5.6 To maintain access to an email account and to regularly check that account and promptly respond to communications from Breadcoin and identify any errors.
- 5.7 To raise any questions, exceptions or discrepancies, including with Breadcoin's monthly accounting, within a reasonable amount of time, typically within thirty days.
- 5.8 To provide proof of the ownership, licenses, and permits required to carry out its function as a vendor when requested by Breadcoin or its agents or assigns.
- 5.9 To be solely responsible for any dispute that may be raised by the customer relating to the foods and services provided.
- 5.10 To comply at all times with all applicable laws and regulations.
- 5.11 To be solely responsible for all applicable taxes for any Vendor sale.
- 5.12 Vendor acknowledges and agrees that Breadcoin tokens are not legal tender.
- 5.13 To seek advance approval from Breadcoin via email, prior to release of any promotion/advertisement material, insofar as the same relates to services offered pursuant to the terms of this Agreement. Breadcoin agrees to respond within a reasonable time period to any such request and not to withhold approval unreasonably.
- 5.14 To allow its name, stories, and images to be used in Breadcoin marketing materials.

6. Additional Rights of Vendor

- 6.1 If Breadcoin undertakes any vendor promotional efforts, Vendor will be included in those marketing efforts. Breadcoin will also, at its sole discretion, include the Vendor in any appropriate promotions to its network of donors and investors.
- 6.2 Vendor is eligible to apply for a Breadcoin small business loan.

7. Warranties, and Representations of Vendor

Vendor warrants and represents that

- 7.1 The signatory to the present agreement has the legal right and full authority to enter into this Agreement.
- 7.2 All obligations narrated under this Agreement are legal, valid, binding and enforceable in law against Vendor.
- 7.3 No legal, regulatory, or other proceedings are currently pending against Vendor that may have a material adverse effect on its ability to perform under this Agreement.
- 7.4 That it is an authorized business establishment and holds all of the requisite permits, licenses, and approvals to conduct its business and to enter into the present agreement with Breadcoin.

8. Termination

8.1 This agreement may be terminated for any or no reason by either party by giving at least thirty-days' notice in writing, including by email.

9. Jurisdiction and Applicable Law

9.1 This agreement is subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of competent courts of law in Washington, D.C. This agreement shall be governed by the laws of Washington D.C.

10. Notices

10.1 All notices and communication shall be via email, in English language. Official contact details are listed in Appendix A.

11. Miscellaneous

11.1 This Agreement embodies the entire agreement and understanding of the Parties and supersedes any and all other prior and contemporaneous agreements, correspondence, arrangements and understandings (whether written or oral) between the Parties with respect to its subject matter. This Agreement may be signed in one or more counterparts, with each part being an original document, and together constituting the entire Agreement.

Breadcoin is at liberty to refuse such consent at its sole discretion.
- 11.4 No waiver of any breach of any provision of this Agreement constitutes a waiver of any prior, concurrent or subsequent breach of the same or any other provisions, and will not be effective unless made in writing and signed by an authorized representative of the waiving Party.
- 11.5 Except as expressly set out in this Agreement, no amendment is binding on the Parties unless it is in writing and signed by a duly authorized representative of each of the Parties.
