How Does a Vendor Get Paid?


Each month, a Breadcoin representative will stop by your location to redeem Breadcoins. They will count the number of Breadcoins being redeemed and record the redemption electronically on their phone. Each Breadcoin is redeemed for \$2.50. Breadcoin is using Bill.com to directly deposit the money into your bank account.

HOW BREADCOIN WORKS

Breadcoin is a community food token that provides a meal to those in need with the dignity of choice. Individuals or organizations purchase Breadcoins to be distributed in the community. The coin recipient takes that physical token to one of our participating locations to purchase a meal with each token worth \$2.50. This provides the dignity of choice in what, where and when to eat.

The local businesses accept Breadcoins and redeem them for cash. Breadcoin also offers microloans to these participating businesses that are paid back in Breadcoins.

BECOME A MEMBER

Many individuals aren't directly in contact with food insecure households, and therefore, our recurring donors can purchase Breadcoins each month to put them into the hands of trusted local groups.

A recurring donation of \$25 puts 10 Breadcoins into your community. Donations have 3x the impact because the money stays local longer. It provides support for local nonprofits, it provides a meal to recipients, and it provides revenue for local businesses.
